Selling your Business?

The SME market in the UK in 2025 will likely face a complex and evolving legal environment. Business Asset Disposal Relief and Capital Gains Tax

The government maintaining the £1 million lifetime allowance for BADR means that many small business owners will still benefit from CGT relief on the sale of their businesses, but those with higher gains will face increased tax liabilities once they exceed this threshold. You could argue that this could result in fewer business owners opting to sell at higher valuations, thus potentially reducing Mergers and Acquisitions (M&A) activity.

What it should do is reinforce the leaders focus to not make tax the driver for realising value but there needs driven by the business strategic intent.

Ultimately, the £1 million cap could create a more complex and cautious M&A environment, especially for SMEs, but also may prompt innovative deal-making and tax planning strategies.

The October budget announcement of an increase in the rate of BADR from 10% to 14% as of April 2025 and again to 18% in April 2026, will have a significant. The immediate effect might be a rush of deals before the tax change, followed by a potential cooling of M&A activity as business owners adjust their expectations. Buyers could also adjust their offer prices or deal structures to account for the higher tax liabilities, potentially making M&A deals more complex and less frequent.

While the increase in CGT might discourage some sellers and create challenges for dealmakers, it could also lead to more creative deal structuring, including the use of deferred payments, asset sales, and tax-efficient financing arrangements. However, the overall effect would likely be a slower M&A market, with more caution from both buyers and sellers in the short to medium term.

Exit options – Management Buyout and Employee Owned Trusts
Both Management Buyouts (MBOs) and Employee Owned Trusts
(EoTs) allow owners to sell their businesses while potentially
benefiting from lower CGT rates. A MBO does not have special tax
treatment, just the EOT, as long as they meet the relevant tax relief
conditions. However, the specific structuring of the transaction is
key to ensuring these preferential tax rates are utilised. Both are
relative quick and potentially elegant, more amicable exit
solutions.

A MBO in the UK occurs when a company's management team acquires the business they operate, typically with the help of external financing. The management team, led by senior executives, takes control of the company, often purchasing shares from the existing owners or investors. MBOs are common in

privately held firms and are used as a strategy for succession planning, corporate restructuring, or to gain more control over the business's direction. Financing for MBOs typically comes from a mix of debt and equity, often facilitated by private equity firms or hanks

An EOT is a model in the UK where a trust owns a company on behalf of its employees. The company's shares are transferred to the trust, which holds them for the benefit of all employees, often providing a share in the company's success through dividends or potential capital growth. EOTs are typically used as a succession planning tool, allowing business owners to sell their company while ensuring employees benefit from ownership. The model offers tax advantages, including exemption from capital gains tax for the selling owners, making it an attractive option for business transition

Through his strength and determination, and the amazing support of Macmillan (who we owe so much to), he went through major surgery and chemotherapy and is now back to his former self.



BORDERLINE CASES David Havns

I remember learning, when I was a young boy, what would no doubt be considered today to be a 'politically incorrect', perhaps even racist, rhyme which ran: 'Taffy was a Welshman/ Taffy was a thief/ Taffy came to my house/ And stole a leg of beef'. To a child such as myself, growing up in the south-east of England, the words meant little. Since I came to live over fifty years ago in the part of Cheshire which borders onto Wales, I have come to understand their significance. Folk memory of early cross-border conflict is preserved in the local legend surrounding the Iron Age hill fort of Maiden Castle on the crest of the Bickerton Hills. The people who are thought to have lived there would have belonged to the Celtic people known as the Cornovii, whose tribal headquarters were originally on the Wrekin in Shropshire. The name Maiden Castle is popularly thought to hark back to a time when the men of the community were away and the women feared that an attack was imminent from the wild tribes who lived west of the Dee. The quick-thinking women dressed themselves in bright red cloaks and paraded themselves on the crest of the hill. From a distance, the marauding Welshmen thought that they were the men of the hill fort, dressed in their battle robes. Considering the opposition to be too strong for them the attackers turned tail and fled back home. The real ex-planation for the name is rather less exciting and it is thought to mean 'an unused castle', dating from after the time when Maiden Castle had been abandoned. However, another intriguing explanation for the name suggests that it means 'old fortification offering a privacy where maidens may indulge their fancy'!

Cheshire communities like Malpas which lay right in the Welsh Marches or borderlands (the term 'march' is derived from the old word 'mere', meaning a boundary) were particularly aware of the 'Welshmen at the gate'. Following the Norman Conquest of 1066, it was in exchange for keeping the Marches under control that local Norman lords were permitted to build castles for themselves, such as those at Malpas, Shocklach and Aldford. Around the year 1320 the people of Cholmondeley drew up a petition requesting that their chapel, four miles east from Malpas parish church, might be fully licensed for burials, baptisms and other rites. They claimed that: '... the Dead in time of war are buried in the fields because Malpas Church is so near Wales that part of the parish belongs to the Welsh and part to the English, wherefore the English dare not go to the Church in war-time.'

The actual border seems to have moved around considerably since Saxon times. It has been suggested that at one time, perhaps as late as the 7th century, the border actually ran along the River Gowy, on the far side of the mid-Cheshire Ridge, and through Maesfen (the name is Welsh for 'field at the boundary') on the east side of Malpas parish. The original Celtic name for the Gowy was Terfyn, also Welsh and meaning 'boundary' (literally 'land at the end'), giving its name to the village of Tarvin, near which the river runs. 



Gardening Tips with Barry Grain

April is a very busy month at Rosemeade, with potting, sowing and the first batches of softwood cuttings being taken. There are a few tricks to seed sowing to ensure good germination, and we always follow these steps, 1. Whether you prefer a pot or a seed tray first loosely fill it and level the top with your hand, 2. Consolidate the compost by pressing down gently on the surface. we either use a piece of made-to-measure plywood or put the same size pot or tray on top and firm. 3. Even sowing is really important to help prevent damping off, so try putting small seeds into the palm of your hand and tap the side of that hand opposite to your thumb. This allows seeds to drop onto the soil gradually and is far easier to control than using your fingers, 4. Top with compost or vermiculite and lightly water. Over in the garden we are now cutting back overwintering growth on Penstemons and Salvias now that young shoots can be seen, and the hardest frosts now behind us. Summer plant supports get placed towards the end of the month before plants get too large to handle. Above all April is one of the very best months to be in your garden, make sure vou savour it.

Later the border may have migrated far to the west and been marked by the construction around AD.700 of Wat's Dyke, the earthworks of which can still be clearly traced running from Wynnstay Park to Erddigg, most visibly from the public footpath in the fields just east of the A.483 road. It may have moved even further west with the construction of King Offa's great Dyke in the late 8th century. This wandering around of the border has made its mark in the names of local villages. On the present Welsh side of the border we have places with the dis-tinctly Anglo-Saxon place-name endings of 'ton' and 'ley': Overton, Sutton, Wallington, Sontley, Rid-ley, Althrey. On the English side we have names of Welsh origin: Crewe (by Farndon), Maesfen, Tarvin, Iscoyd. It was not until the early 10th century that Cheshire's boundaries started to be fixed, with the River Dee presenting itself as an obvious natural border line.

It will provide a community area that will encourage greater use of the hall but will also be free for use by all including visitors to The Carden Arms, Tilston School, Tilston Playing Fields, The Wakes and all local residents.

The design has been prepared following appropriate arboricultural and ecological surveys to protect all existing flora & fauna and incorporates sustainable drainage provisions to maximise environmental benefits. Proposed EV charging facilities may also be included once suitable infrastructure becomes available.

It is proposed that all works will be paid for by grants and fund raising efforts incurring no direct cost to local residents. However, to help grant applications we need to show that these proposals have full community support. 
