





Planning a tax-smart retirement

Some days you can't imagine ever retiring. Other days, you wish you were hanging up your boots tomorrow. But when the day comes, you want to start retirement with a sense of anticipation of all that lies ahead, safe in the knowledge that you've put enough money by for a comfortable retirement.

And that takes careful financial planning.

These days, retirement planning is about making sure you've got plenty of options to live later-life the way you want to — not the way your income means you have to. But the more you've saved, the more choices — and peace of mind — you'll have in later life.

Buying yourself some choices

When you do come to retire, you'll almost certainly be using your pension or ISA savings as one of your main sources of income. Both of these can help shelter your dividends, interest or other profit from both Income and Capital Gains Tax, which can make your money go much further.

The first step is to audit what you've got. Make sure each of your assets is working as tax-efficiently as possible, and what return you're getting, in case you want to move some cash into an ISA or your pension ahead of tax year-end. Each one has a varying degree of risk, and tax-efficiency. That's why it really pays to use your tax allowances and reliefs each year to boost your pension pot, as you get closer to that retirement party.

ISAs and pensions - know your allowances

One of the best ways to boost your pension pot this tax year is to use your full pension annual allowance of £60,000 if you can. This figure includes contributions from yourself, your employer, and any third party as well as tax relief paid to the pension — and it resets every new tax year. Just to be clear, if you're paying into more than one pension, you'll still only have an annual allowance of £60,000 in total pension contributions — not £60,000 per pension.

However, you'll only personally get tax relief on contributions up to 100% of your earnings, or £3,600 – whichever is lower – in each tax year. If you're a higher earner – above £200,000 – your annual allowance may 'taper off'.

If you haven't maxed-out your allowance in the previous three tax years, you can carry it forward. Any amount paid in excess of your available annual allowance, including any carried forward, will be subject to Income tax.

What other allowances could I use to boost my retirement income?

The tax breaks don't stop at pensions and ISAs - you have

some other annual allowances too. If you make a profit from selling assets outside your ISA or pension, the annual Capital Gains Tax (CGT) exemption for 2024/25 is £3,000. Do be aware that you may need to pay CGT on any gain above that amount. The Chancellor made significant changes to the rates of CGT in the Autumn Budget.

You can't carry the CGT allowance over so it's a 'use-it-orlose-it' tax break. But you can offset losses you made selling other assets to bring any CGT gain down (you do need to declare both gains and losses on your self-assessment tax return).

If you've already used up your ISA allowance, there's still the Personal Savings Allowance (PSA), which can save you tax too. You can earn up to £1,000 of interest before you start being taxed in this tax year, if you're a basic-rate taxpayer. This drops to £500 per year for higher-rate taxpayers, and additional-rate taxpayers can't claim at all.

Finally, think about any dividends you earn. Dividends earned from shares held in ISAs or received by pensions are tax free. You can earn up to £500 before you pay tax if the dividends sit outside those 'wrappers'.

The Dividend Tax for basic-rate taxpayers in 2024/25 is 8.75% and 33.75% for higher-rate taxpayers. For additional-rate payers, the rate is 39.35%.

Taking financial advice for your retirement planning

ROADS AND LANES LEADING TO A VANISHED PAST David Hayns

Holywell Lane at Clutton, Sadlers Wells in Bunbury and Well Street in Malpas. Do they have anything in common apart from the 'well' element in their names? It is said that a spring arose near Clutton after the body of Saint Winifred, more famously associated with Holywell in North Wales, was rested there in the 7th century on the way to burial in her shrine in Shrewsbury Abbey. Sadlers Wells is now a modern residential road in Bunbury but is shown as an existing road on the 1840s Tithe Map, running alongside the Manorial Allotments owned by John Tollemache. The 1878 Ordnance Survey map shows a well next to the road, adjacent to the allotments, so this is probably one of the original 'Sadlers Wells' providing a water supply for allotment holders, belonging originally to someone named Sadler. Tempting as it is to conjecture, there is no evidence to connect it with Sadler's Wells theatre in London, the birthplace of the Royal Ballet. Well Street in Malpas led to the original town well, the main public water supply from the 18th century, and maybe earlier.

Features which may once have been encountered by travellers were bridges or 'platts' (Platts Lane, Tattenhall) and fords (Ford Lane, Tattenhall and Goldford [cold ford?] Lane, Bickerton). Former important uses of roads are hinted at by Old Coach Road, which was the original stage coach route, now replaced by the A.41, for the road between Broxton and Hampton; Salters Way, part of the A.534 at Bickerton, on the line of the former salt trading route from Nantwich into North Wales; and Highwayside, part of the A.51 to the north of Bunbury, which at one time was part of the important main road known as 'The Great Highway', from London to Holyhead.

Former agricultural connections are remembered by Townfield Lane, Farndon, which led to one of the medieval open fields; Wetreins ('wet furrows') Lane running from Crewe-by-Farndon to Stretton; and Market Place at Hampton where a housing development stands on the site of the former livestock auction, opened in the 1870s and closed in 1989.

Some road names are clues that some of the buildings in them, now private houses, once served their local communities in a variety of ways. Beeston has Chapel Lane where can be found the former Primitive Methodist chapel opened in 1911 and closed for worship in 1971. Another former ecclesiastical building is commemorated by College Lane in Bunbury. When Sir Hugh Calveley rebuilt Saint Boniface church in the 14th century he designed it as a 'collegiate' church, served by a number of chantry priests who lived in their own premises in College Lane. The priests would have been endowed to pray for the souls of the departed, a system which survived until 1548 when King Edward VI did away with chantries. Hampton has two 'post' references in its road names. The former post office, now a private house, is in Post Office Lane whereas Hampton Post Lane, running from Bickerton Road/Long Lane to Hampton Post crossroads, is a reminder that



near there, as George Ormerod wrote in his History of Cheshire (1819), stood once 'an old tree standing in the road of Chester way, from Whitchurch, and reckoned for a mark for Passengers travelling that way'. The tree became known as Hampton Post. Burwardsley's Barracks Lane, location of the recently closed Cheshire Workshops, takes its name from a row of cottages demolished in the 1970s. They may have been converted from a 17th century manor house and possibly at one time they served as a barracks to house itinerant workmen, such as Irish harvesters, or stonemasons employed in the many quarries found in and around Burwardsley.

To end on a romantic note, let's move back to Malpas where the former deep, shady and narrow road, forming the ancient boundary between Malpas and Overton townships on its way down to Overton Heath, once officially called Overton Lane has become known as Love Lane. I wonder why?






