





SAFE STRONGHOLDS David Havns

Beeston Castle stands out as a heavily defended stronghold, well portrayed by Robin Gleek's atmospheric photograph on the cover of My Village News for February 2025. It is a former Royal castle, perched on a rocky sandstone crag 350 feet (107 m) above the Cheshire Plain. Built in the 1220s by Ranulf de Blondeville, 6th Earl of Chester (1170-1232), on his return from the Crusades, it is part of a network of major castles (Chester, Shotwick, Frodsham, Macclesfield and Beeston), with lesser baronial castles including, in our area, Malpas. A number of other minor strongholds of the motte-and-bailey type were built along the frontier with Wales, including Aldford, Shocklach and maybe Oldcastle. The Castle was not the first fortification on Beeston Hill and excavations in the 1960s and 1970s discovered evidence for a hillfort dating from the Bronze Age (c.3.000-c.1.200 BC). Better known are the visible remains of Maiden Castle, in the form of ramparts and a ditch on Bickerton Hill, one of a chain of Iron Age (c.1.200 BC - c.55 AD) hillforts running from Helsby Hill down to, possibly, Oldcastle. Archaeologists are still undecided on how to interpret the earthworks (now covered by trees) overlooking the Wych Brook at Oldcastle - hillfort, or medieval castle? There are well over a thousand hillforts known in England, originating in the Bronze and Iron Ages. It is not known for all of them why they were constructed. Certainly many were for defensive purposes and were the sites of violent conflict, such as the more famous Maiden Castle in Dorset where badly wounded bodies have been excavated. However, others were probably just settlement sites, or served other purposes such as livestock enclosures, tribal meeting places, or trading centres. One leading place-name expert interprets 'Beeston' as meaning 'rock, or hill. where a market is held'.

Right on the edge of the My Village News area and just over the Welsh border are the remains of another stone-built castle, at Holt. Built for Edward 1st soon after his invasion of North Wales in 1277, it became known as 'Castrum Leonis' or 'Castle Lyons' after the lion motif carved into the stonework above its main gate. The village sign, which faces you as you come into Holt from the bypass, features an excellent depiction of the original castle. Both Beeston and Holt played significant roles during the 17th century Civil Wars. During most of the conflict Holt was a Royalist (Cavalier) garrison, whereas Beeston changed sides a number of times. Both were 'reduced' (demolished) by the Parliamentarians (Roundheads) after the end of the wars and much of their stonework was recycled, in various ways. Some stone from Holt was shipped up the Dee to help build the first Eaton Hall, seat of the Dukes of Westminster. Stone from Beeston was 'robbed' and used for less exalted work, including the repair of roads in the surrounding townships. There are some interesting videos about the histories of both castles, to be found on Youtube.



Also seeing action during the Civil Wars was the Royalist garrison at Cholmondeley House, forerunner of the present Cholmondeley Castle, The timber-framed house was assaulted and finally taken by the Parliamentarians in 1643/4. It was rendered so uninhabitable that after the war the staunchly Royalist Lord Cholmondelev had to move out and live for the rest of his life at Bickley Hall (now the headquarters of the Cheshire Wildlife Trust). In 1801-4 a new house, described by Peysner as 'in the Gothick style, battlemented but not otherwise castle-like', was built on another site within the park. Considerable alterations were made in 1828/9, when new features included a tower and tower-like features, and new battlements with machiolations (the holes through which boiling oil could be poured onto attackers!). Another village, just outside our area, which was garrisoned and attacked at times by both Royalists and Parliamentarians, is Tarvin. In 1644 the Parliamentarians fortified the village by surrounding it with a substantial rampart, of which all traces have now vanished. Tarvin remained in their hands until the end of the war. Even some of our parish churches were involved. At Holt there are depressions in the walls of St Chad's, caused by musket balls, and Malpas church was at one time used as an overnight dormitory for Parliamentarian troops from the garrison at Nantwich. In 1643 Farndon church was being used as a barracks for the Parliamentarians when it was attacked and badly damaged by the Royalists.

Enigmatic clues to other possible once fortified sites in our area are provided by place-names containing the element 'burgh' or 'bury' from which is derived the terms 'borough' and 'burgess'. We have Bunbury ('Buna's stronghold'), Marbury ('fortified place near a lake') and Norbury ('northern stronghold'). These three villages received their early English names before the Norman Conquest of 1066 and their origins are difficult to determine – but there are clues in their names to suggest that our local countryside was not always so peaceful as it is today!




TILSTON COMMUNITY CAR PARK & OPEN SPACE PROJECT


